

How to share a YouTube video on a Zoom call



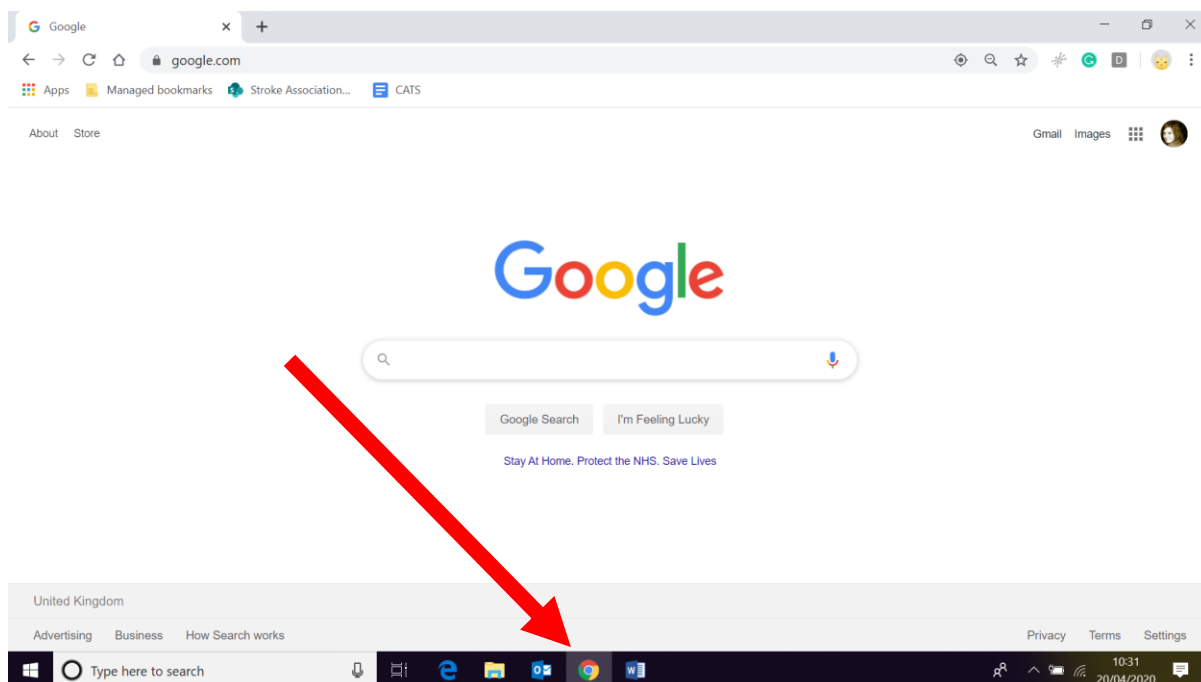

- **How to play a YouTube video on a Zoom call** so that **everyone** can **see** and **hear** it too.

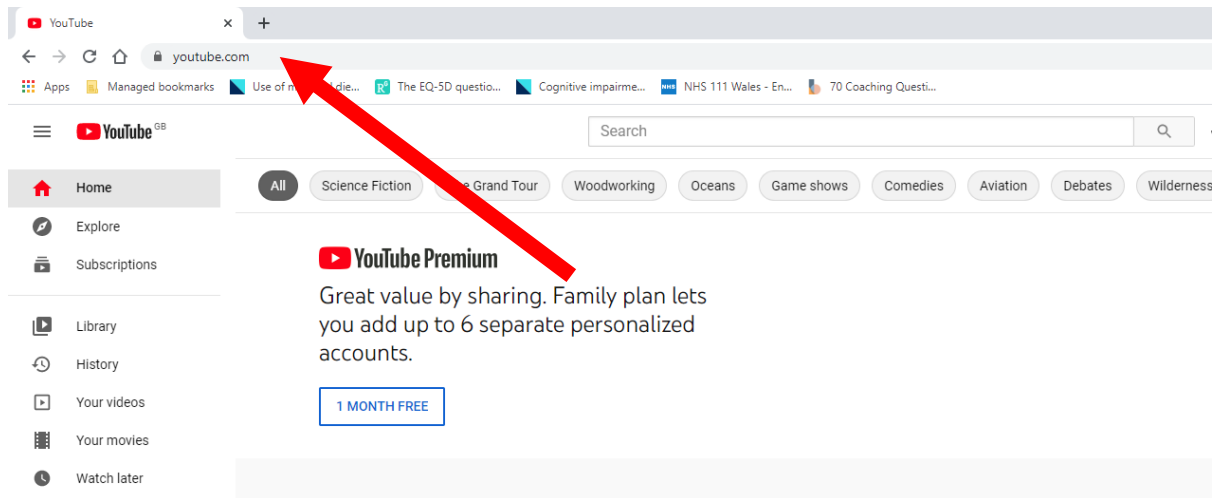
Sharing a Youtube video on a computer

1. **Open your computer browser.** This might be Chrome, Firefox, Internet Explorer or Safari.

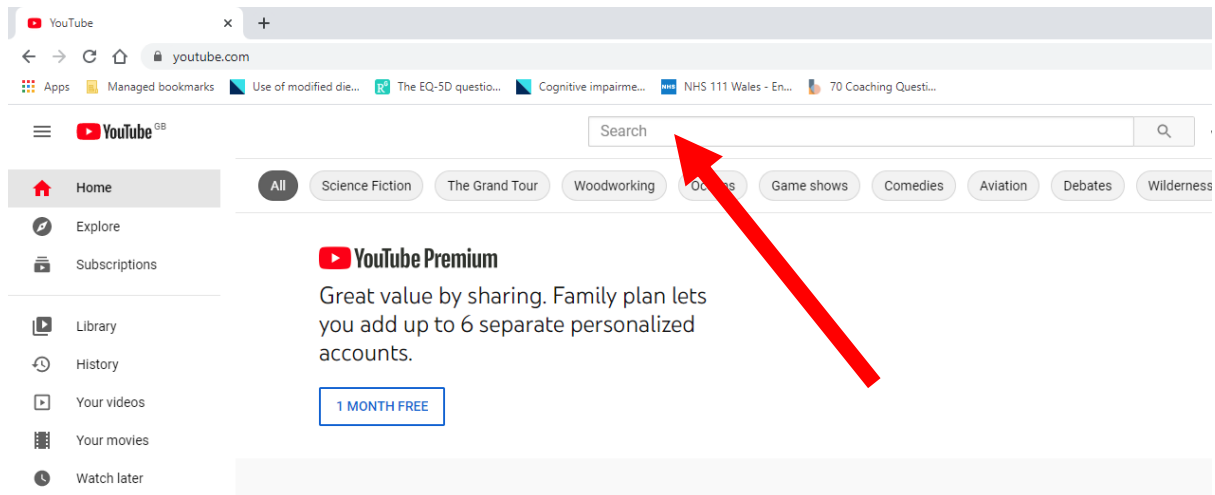


2. Visit the **YouTube** website.

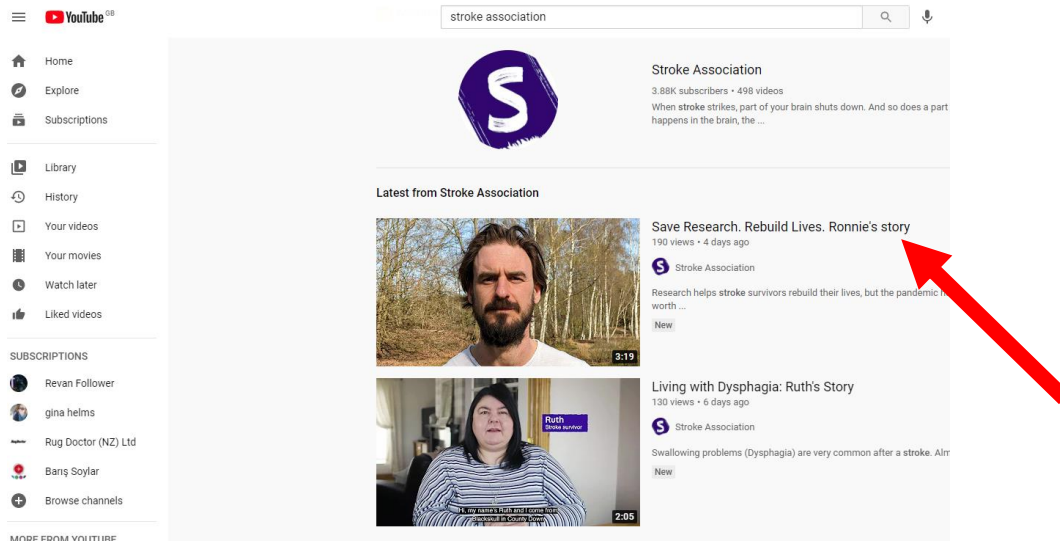
Type youtube.com into your **computer browser**.



3. **Search** for the **video** you want to share.




4. Click on the video.



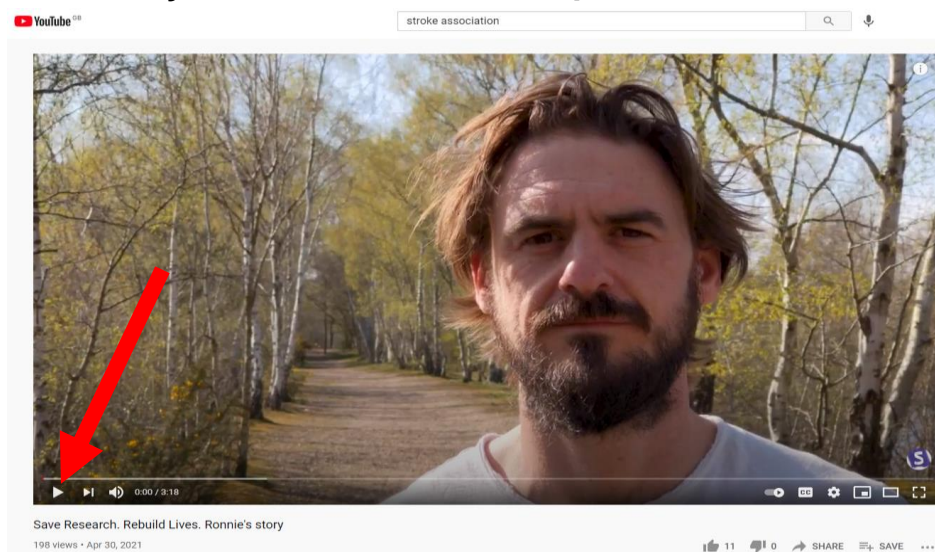
If you have a **link** to a YouTube video you want to share. E.g.

<https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=ndHyx7KFL94>

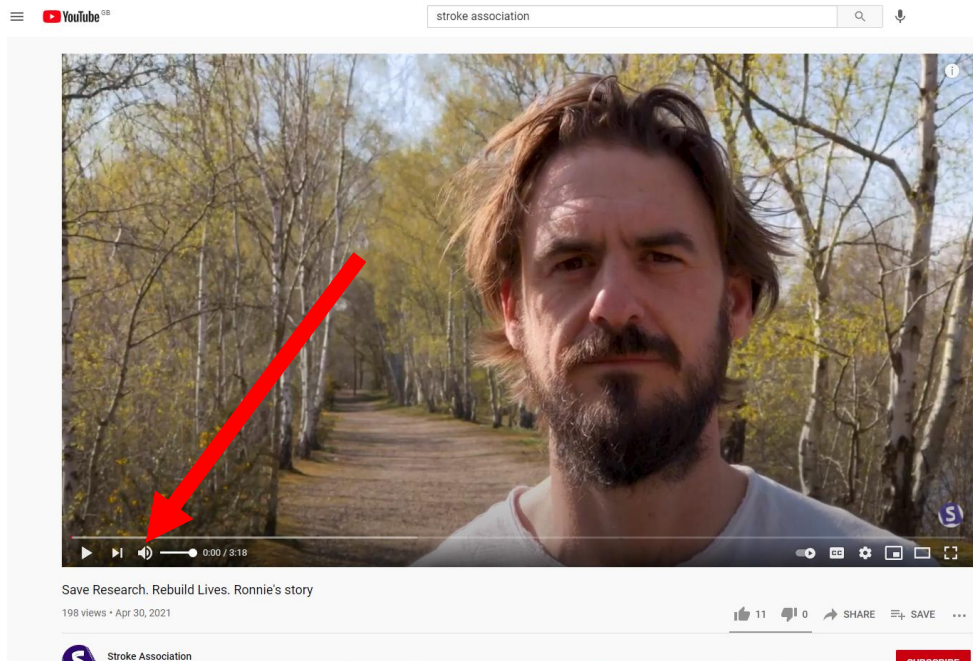
Press and hold **Ctrl**  on your **keyboard** and **click** on the **link** to open it in your browser.

5. Pause the video.

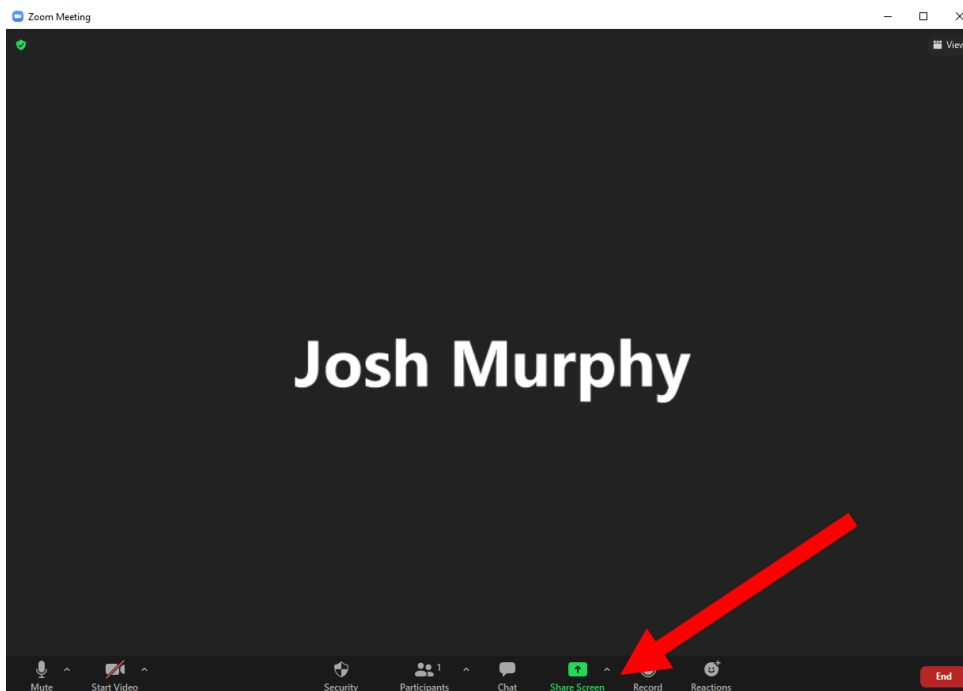
Leave your **browser** window open.



6. Check that the **volume** on the video is **turned up**.



7. In you **Zoom** call click the green '**Share Screen**' icon.

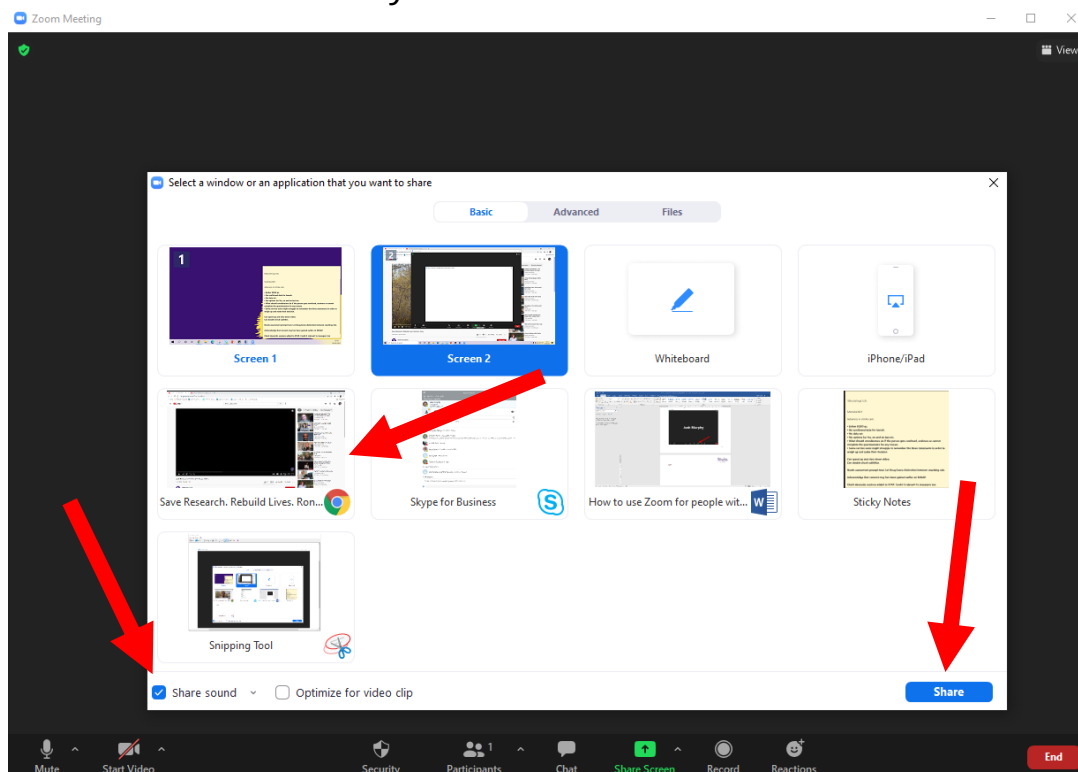


8. Select 'Share sound'.

Select the **browser window** with the **YouTube video** displayed.

Click 'Share'.

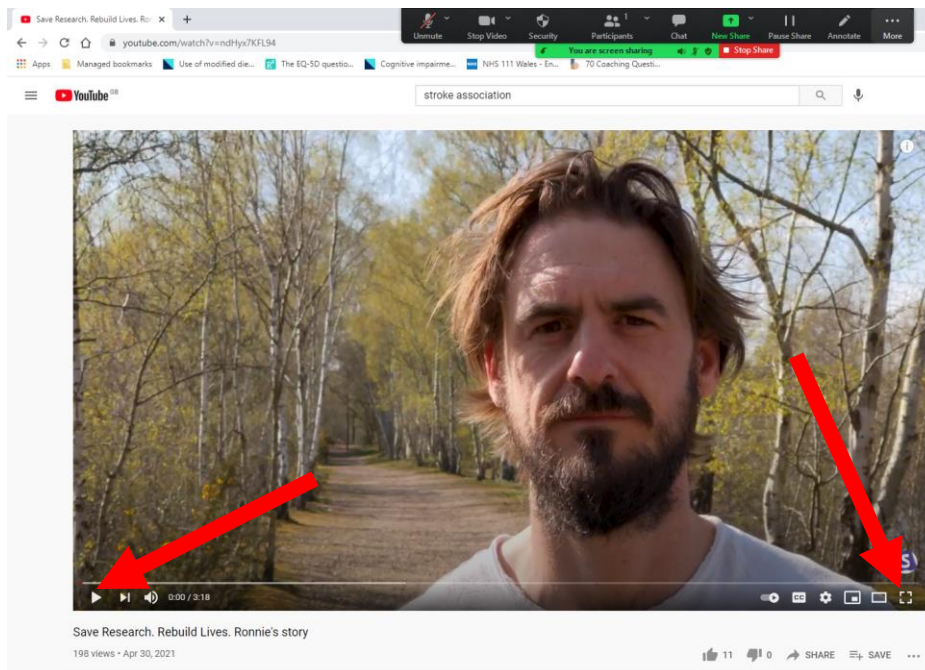
Please note: Other **people** on the Zoom call will **not hear** the YouTube video **unless** you select 'Share sound'.



9. Click the 'Full screen' icon.

Click 'Play'.

Everyone on the Zoom call should now be able to **see** and **hear** the YouTube video.



10. Click on 'Stop share' at the top of the screen when you would like to stop sharing the YouTube video.
